

Introduction

In August 2015, community leaders and urban advocates raised concerns about the rapid pace of redevelopment across the city. While modernization brings economic opportunities, it also threatens historic neighborhoods, green space, and long-standing community traditions.

This report, "Save Our City," was prepared to highlight the risks of uncontrolled development and to call for a more balanced approach that respects both progress and heritage.

Key Concerns

1. **Displacement of Residents**
Redevelopment has led to rising rents and the loss of affordable housing.
 2. **Loss of Historic Character**
Iconic buildings and neighborhood identities are being replaced by high-rise developments.
 3. **Environmental Strain**
Increased traffic, reduced air quality, and limited green space have all been linked to unregulated construction.

- **Pause Large-Scale Projects** until updated environmental and social impact studies are completed.
 - **Strengthen Zoning Protections** for heritage areas.
 - **Engage Community Groups** in long-term planning decisions.
